Memorandum

Agreement on mutual information exchange between ASCCT and JSAAE

We, the President of the American Society for Cellular and Computational Toxicology and the President of the Japanese Society for Alternatives to Animal Experiments have agreed to send this memorandum each other to strengthen our two societies' friendship.

- We agree to mutually exchange information relevant to our academic activities. The mutual information exchange will be made through the following means;

 1. The exchange of experts in this field, alternatives to animal experimentation (3Rs).

 2. The mutual arrangement of academic meetings, symposium and workshops in this field together.

 3. The mutual exchange of educational tools of 3Rs.

 4. Any other means to strengthen our two societies' friendship.

Agreement sets the stage for continued and sustained engagement between our two societies by the end of 2018.

This agreement can be revised upon a request of the society and an agreement between our two societies.
